1. California Naturally

Focus: The Beauty of Nature

Landscapes, plants, natural wonders, waterways, coastlines, forests, deserts, and other images celebrating the beauty of our environment. *Let nature be the star of the photo.*

2. Wildlife

Focus: Animals in Their Natural World

Capture wildlife in its natural habitat—from birds and butterflies to marine life and California's larger wildlife. *Celebrate the creatures that share our environment.*

3. Through a Different Lens

Focus: Creative & Technical Photography

Show the environment from a unique perspective. Aerial photography, unusual angles, close-ups, patterns, textures, and other creative or technical approaches are welcome. *Give us a view of the environment we might otherwise miss.*

4. Sparkle Team — Humanity meets Environmental!

Focus: Service + People + Impact

Capture Lions and Leos working together to improve the places where we live. Cleanups, graffiti removal, beautification, conservation, neighborhood projects, and other hands-on efforts belong here. *Show the teamwork and transformation that make communities sparkle!*

5. Rooted in Service

Focus: The Story of Service

Inspired by Lions International President Mark Lyon theme, "Rooted in Service." Capture an image that tells a deeper story about people, service, community, and our connection to the environment.

Show us what being Rooted in Service means through your lens.

6. Move Be-Cause — Move Naturally!

Focus: Health + Movement + Nature

Capture Lions, Leos, families, or friends getting healthy while enjoying the outdoors. Walk, roll, hike, cycle, swim, stretch, exercise, or show us your own way to move in nature. *Selfies are encouraged! Show us your best moves and how the outdoors inspires healthy living.*

Contest Essentials

- Photos must be original and taken by the submitting photographer.
- Print size: 8" x 10" on high-quality photo paper.
- One submission per club, per category. Lions Clubs and Leo Clubs are counted separately.
- Photos must be taken during the current 2026-2027 Lions year.
- Entries must be received by February 1, 2027
- Photos will be displayed for voting at the MD4 Convention in Rohnert Park, February 19–21, 2027.
- Winners will be announced Saturday, February 20, 2027, during the evening awards ceremony.

- Brief Description of the Photo
