For Lions Clubs, the biggest opportunity is to turn awareness into action before school starts. Here are six simple, visible, and impactful service projects for Children's Eye Health and Safety Month (August): The possibilities are endless!

1. Back-to-School Vision Screening Day

Partner with a local school, library, community center, or youth organization to provide free vision screenings and referrals.

Impact: Identifies children who may be struggling with undiagnosed vision issues before classes begin.

2. "See to Succeed" School Supply Drive

Collect school supplies along with child-friendly sunglasses, eye safety information, and vision resource flyers.

Impact: Supports academic success while educating families about eye health.

3. Lions Eye Health Awareness Booth

Set up an information table at a community event, farmers market, or back-to-school fair.

Include:

- Signs of vision problems in children
- Importance of comprehensive eye exams
- Eye safety tips for sports and recreation
- Local vision resources

Impact: Reaches hundreds of families with prevention and awareness messaging.

4. Sports Eye Safety Campaign

Partner with youth sports leagues to distribute protective eyewear information and eye safety reminders.

Impact: Helps prevent sports-related eye injuries.

5. Story Time & Vision Awareness

Host a children's reading event at a library or school.

Include:

- Reading by Lions volunteers
- Eye health activity sheets
- Vision awareness handouts for parents

Impact: Connects vision health directly to learning and literacy.

6. Sponsor a Child Eye Exam Initiative

Work with local optometrists to provide vouchers or financial assistance for children needing comprehensive eye exams and glasses.

Impact: Removes barriers for families who cannot afford care.

Challenge your club to:

- Screen 25 children
- Distribute 25 eye health packets
- Sponsor 25 eye exams or referrals
- Share 25 vision awareness social media posts
