California Lions Project Care – Access, Inclusion & Advocacy

September offers a unique opportunity for Lions to raise awareness, remove barriers, and create more inclusive communities through service.

1. Community Accessibility Walk Audit

Partner with local disability advocates to evaluate sidewalks, parks, public buildings, and community gathering spaces.

Service Action:

- **Identify accessibility barriers**
- **Document findings**
- **Share recommendations with city leaders**

Impact: Creates safer and more accessible communities for everyone.

2. Memory Café for Families

In recognition of World Alzheimer's Day (September 21), host a social gathering for individuals living with dementia and their caregivers.

Service Action:

- **Games, music, conversation, and refreshments**
- **Resource tables from local support organizations**

Impact: Reduces isolation and supports caregivers.

3. Hydrocephalus Awareness & Family Support Project

In recognition of World Hydrocephalus Day (September 20).

Service Action:

- **Invite a speaker or family to share their journey**
- **Create awareness displays**

- **Collect comfort items or gift cards for affected families**

Impact: Educates the community about a condition many have never heard of.

4. Learn Sign Language Challenge

In recognition of International Day of Sign Language (September 23) and the International Week of the Deaf.

Service Action:

- **Teach basic signs such as:**
 - **Hello**
 - **Thank You**
 - **Friend**
 - **Lion**
 - **Service**
- **Create short social media videos**

Impact: Promotes communication, inclusion, and understanding.

5. Accessible Movie or Event Night

Host a community event featuring:

- **Closed captioning**
- **Reserved accessible seating**
- **Large-print materials**
- **Quiet spaces**
- **Accessible / Barile/ Large Print Bingo- buy on Amazon**

Impact: Demonstrates how small accommodations create welcoming experiences.

6. Technology for Access Workshop

Help seniors and individuals with disabilities learn about:

- **Smartphone accessibility features**
- **Voice assistants**
- **Screen readers**
- **Captioning tools**

Impact: Increases independence and confidence.

7. Hearing Health & Communication Fair

Partner with hearing professionals and deaf advocacy groups.

Service Action:

- **Hearing screenings**
- **Captioning demonstrations**
- **Assistive technology displays**

Impact: Raises awareness of communication access needs.

8. Access for All Community Challenge

Challenge clubs to improve one accessibility feature in their community.

Examples:

- **Accessible picnic tables**
- **Braille signage**
- **Sensory-friendly spaces**
- **Accessible garden paths**
- **Wheelchair-accessible service projects**

Impact: Leaves a lasting accessibility legacy.

9. “Different Abilities, One Community” Awareness Campaign

Share stories throughout September highlighting community members living with:

- **Alzheimer’s disease**
- **Hearing loss**
- **Hydrocephalus**
- **Vision loss**
- **Mobility challenges**
- **Developmental disabilities**

Impact: Focuses on abilities, inclusion, and human connection.
